


SUBJECT: 2009-2010 SPANISH INTERPRETER SERVICE GUIDELINES

Pending approval from the Board of Trustees, the identified parties hereby agree that beginning the 2009-2010 school year, interpreter services for ARD meetings are considered the responsibility of each campus. The campus Principal will identify a campus interpreter(s) and ensure that the selected individual(s) attend the Interpreter Training offered through the Special Education Department. It is mandatory that the selected campus person(s) be a fluent Spanish speaker and be either a teaching assistant or professional staff member. If a campus has large numbers of ARDs needing interpreter services, the campus will need to identify multiple trained interpreters to ensure that the IEP services of special education students continue to be delivered. The training is provided several times per year and may be offered during the summer if there is enough interest. Once trained, the campus interpreter must attend a Refresher Training session every two (2) years. The Interpreter training is offered through e-Campus.
